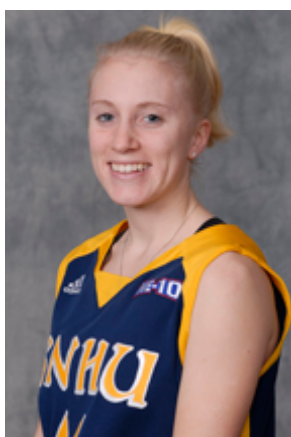

2008: Named a First Team All-American by Inside Lacrosse magazine and a Second Team All-American by IWLCA/US Lacrosse and womenslacrosse.com...also an IWLCA All-Region selection...Northeast-10 Defensive Player of the Year and First Team All-Conference...also named a Second Team ESPN the Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-American...one of three players to start all 18 games...led SNHU in ground balls (62), draw controls (56) and caused turnovers (50)...ranked second in the NE-10 in caused turnovers and fourth in ground balls...also added 12 goals and 13 assists...had seven ground balls, six draw controls, a goal and two assists in a win over Assumption (3/15)...collected eight ground balls in a win over Saint Anselm (3/19)...tallied two goals and an assist at Molloy (3/27)...scored twice in a win over Dowling, including the game-winning goal (3/28)...totaled a goal and three assists in a win over American International (4/15)...had seven draw controls, six ground balls and a goal and two assists in SNHU's NE-10 semifinal win over Bryant (5/2).

2007: Northeast-10 Second Team selection...one of three players to start all 14 games and ranked second on the squad with 17 assists...also scored seven goals for 24 points...led team in ground balls (50) and caused turnovers (32) while ranking third in draw controls (24)...handed out four assists in a season-opening win over Bentley (3/24)...followed that up with five assists in a win over Franklin Pierce (3/27)...scored four times in a win at Saint Michael's (4/10)...recorded three assists in a win at American International (4/18).





2006: Played in all 13 games and started 12...led team in caused turnovers (19) and ranked second in both ground balls (42) and draw controls (28)...also registered eight goals and six assists for 14 points...collected season-high six ground balls in collegiate debut against Assumption (3/28)...registered a goal and two assists while also recording five ground balls in a win over AIC (4/6)...had the game-winning goal and totaled a goal and two assists in a 14-13 win over Saint Anselm (4/17)...finished with a goal and an assist at Bryant (4/22)...scored twice in a win over Saint Michael's (4/25).
